Fluoride Test Kit Information

It is important to have your well water tested for fluoride content. Fluoride is naturally occurring in groundwater and therefore may be in your well water in trace amounts, adequate amounts or even excessive amounts than the recommended level. It is wrong to assume that well water has no fluoride. The best way to be sure your child is receiving the appropriate amount of systemic fluoride is to have your well water tested for fluoride content.
